Sara Thies, Street Administrator, was here to tell us about snow removal on the streets. After 1" of snow, there is no parking on snow routes and after 2" of snow, don't park on the side streets. No parking tickets are \$35. Her phone number 283-4950.

Doua Lor, Des Moines Police Department, gave his report on what is happening.

Randy Dickson from U-Haul told about the plans his company has for the old K-Mart. He has been with the company for 35 years. They will employ 10 to 15 people. The length that the average customer uses the storage facility is about 18 months. ½ of the units will be heated and the other ½ units will be climate controlled.

Minutes. Kevin Marken made the motion that the minutes from the last month's meeting be approved as written. Second by Paul Sadler. Motion carried.

Treasurer's Report. The balance in the bank as of the end of December was \$2,070.16. One check has not cleared the bank yet. \$562.61 is in the Operating Expenses and \$1,507.55 in the Grant money.
